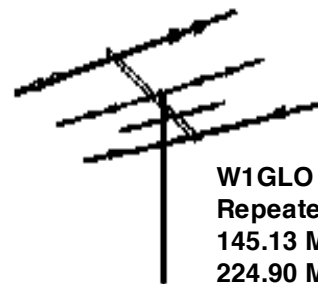

7.3.1 100% Emergency Power (3 transmitters x 100 pts/XTR = 300 points)

All power for CAARA's Field Day operation was provided by a gasoline powered generators. Again this year instead of a single generator supplying power to the entire site, several small 1, 2 and 3 kilowatt inverter type generators were used. The reduced noise was very much appreciated by everyone on the site, and the flexibility to run stations independently was also a plus. The smaller generators were much more efficient and required substantially less fuel.

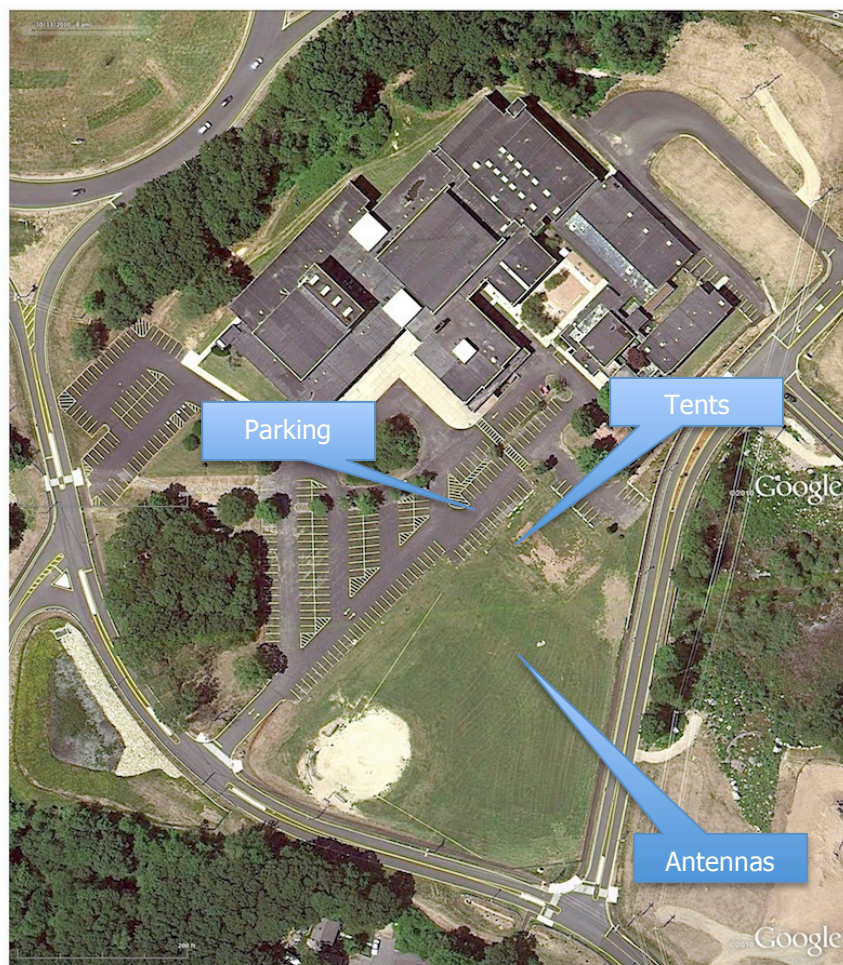

7.3.7 Satellite QSO (0/100 points)

7.3.8 Alternate Power (100/100 points)

Six contacts were made on battery power that was charged with solar cells. A 75-watt BP Solar panel was donated to CAARA from Ron Richards. A MPPT controller was used to charge a AGM 12VDC battery that was used to power the digital station radio directly. Since the digital station runs at lower power (30 to 35 watts), full 13.8VDC was not as critical for operation.



7.3.9 W1AW Bulletin (100/100 bonus points)

The W1AW bulleting was copied on digital this year on 80 m. Next year, more emphasis will be made on copying the message on all modes instead of only digital.

7.3.10 Education Activity (100/100 points)

Gardi Winchester, KA1BTK, gave a hands-on demonstration of HF operations to several new hams at the GOTA station this year.

7.3.11 Site Visitation by an Elected Governmental Official (100/100 points)

City Councillors Paul Lundberg and Bill Fonvielle, State Senator Bruce Tarr and State Representative Ann Margaret Ferrante were all invited and attended. Senator Tarr was instrumental in obtaining a joint resolution from the Massachusetts Senate recognizing Amateur Radio, which he presented to CAARA at Field Day (Senator Tarr is a member of CAARA). Rep. Ferrante presented a citation from the Mass. House of Representatives.

7.3.12 Site Visitation by a Representative of an Agency (100/100 points)

Ron Beckley, a member of the [Red Cross](#) attended the CAARA Field Day operation and supplied wireless Internet service. The Red Cross stationed their Emergency Response Vehicle on-



site for much of Saturday's Field Day operation. Gloucester Police Chief Leonard Campanello visited the site twice, even though a major event (St. Peter's Fiesta) was going on the city. Eric Smith, Gloucester Fire Chief also visited the Field Day site.

7.3.13 GOTA Bonus (0 points)

No QSOs were logged on the GOTA station this year.

7.3.14 Web Submission (50 points)

CAARA's Field Day results were submitted through the applet on www.b4h.net/cabforms/.

7.3.15 Field Day Youth Participation (0 points)

Five visitors were under 18 this year, but none made contacts.

Field Day Guest/Participant Log

There were 59 guest/participants this year in the log, much improved from last year's 35. There were 30 CAARA members (out of a membership of 112) who were either on-site or directly helped during Field Day, with 5 visitors under 18. Five members who were on-site did not sign the log and one who handled traffic for us also is not in the log (Curtis Wright, AA3JE). This brings the total participants to 65.

A concerted effort was made to reach out to local hams with a mail campaign (180 letters sent), and local officials (20 letters sent). Two city councilors (Paul Lundberg and Bill Fonvielle), Massachusetts State Senator Bruce Tarr, State Senator Ann Margaret Ferrante and Red Cross representative (Ron Beckley) all attended. Analysis of the effectiveness of the outreach to local hams has not been completed.

An analysis of club participation was completed, with 27% of the 112 club members participating.
